E&H Foundation was set up in 2012 with a clear vision to provide quality education and preventive health care underprivileged children in India starting from the state of UP.

Every initiative must have a start somewhere and we started with Uttar Pradesh (UP), because of its huge population base of 200 million. If UP were an independent country, it would have probably been the 5th largest country. The Human Development Index (HDI) indicators for UP are one of the lowest in India, and if India has to progress as an economic super power then UP has to progress as well. With E&H Foundation, we are trying to contribute towards the development of UP, and as we evolve by 2020 we will move to other states.

All our accounts are on our website, shared with everyone. Hundred percent of all donations go to the beneficiaries and all overhead costs are taken care by the founder trustees. E&H Foundation has inculcated 'corporatize giving' concept in its management, building a transparent system and maintaining compliance. We continue building on this ideology to make lives better for underprivileged children in India. Since inception, we have enriched the lives of about 19,000 children by supporting their education from Class 1-5 and we aim to impact the lives of 1 Lakh children in the next five years and extend our program from KG till Class 10th. "

OUR IMPACT AND MODELS

AT A GLANCE

E&H (Education and Health) Foundation was set up in 2012 with a vision to provide quality health and education to the underprivileged children in India. After doing in depth research, E&H started its journey from the state of UP and in the past six years, our presence in the region has expanded to over 100 slums and 3 districts. In the future, we would like to extend this vision to other regions and states in India.

In the academic year 2018-2019, E&H Foundation supported the education of 7000 children from Std 1-5 through the GyanShala and Bharti Foundation models in the state of Uttar Pradesh.

Of this, approx 6200 children were covered under the GyanShala model in Farrukhabad and Lucknow districts. Another 720 students were supported through 3 operational Bharti schools in Farrukhabad.

Since inception, the foundation has supported the education of over 19,000 children and aims to reach 1 lakh children by 2025.





Under the flagship program of GyanShala, E&H Foundation supported the education of ~6200 out-of-school children living in slums and villages in the academic year 2018-2019.

We ran a total of 237 classes from Class 1-5 in Farrukhabad and Lucknow in the year 2018-2019. These classes were held in the poorest bastis of these districts. Average monthly income of parents of most children ranges somewhere between Rs 5,000- Rs 8,000.

80% of students coming to these classes are first generation learners and 50% of students under our program are girls. This is extremely good given the average % of girls in private and government schools in UP is much below.

Gyanshala's pedagogy is MIT- USA approved and is designed to serve the children at the bottom of the pyramid. The model, designed by Prof Pankaj Jain, delivers high-quality school education on a mass scale with easily available human and financial resources at low-cost.



BHARTI FOUNDATION

In association with Bharti Foundation, E&H Foundation incepted three primary schools in 2012, which are currently running in rural areas of Farrukhabad district, providing quality education to around 720 children from underprivileged families in the last academic year. Also, in 2018-19, two of our students from Bharti Foundation in Jeona got shortlisted for Shiv Nadar School at 6th Grade level. This has further motivated other students and community members to continue sending children to our schools from Std 1-5. At E&H Foundation, we are building success stories that have the potential to inspire students and communities to get out of the clutches of poverty and have a chance at life.



KEY ACHIEVEMNTS

- In 2018-2019, E&H Foundation enabled quality education for 7000 children.
- Under Gyanshala's model, we achieved grade appropriate learning for at least 70% children.
- 50% of students under the program are girls.
- We delivered Gyanshala's MIT approved pedagogy to marginalized communities. By doing so, we enabled a strong foundation for these students who are first time learners, all hailing from extremely marginalized sections of society.
- We worked with marginalized families and consistently encouraged them to send their children to classes.
- We maintained a cumulative average attendance of 66% in all our classes. This significant attendance is achieved due to year round efforts of field officers, teachers, program supervisors, parents and the entire community.
- In the final examinations conducted at the end of March, of the total students enrolled in 237 classes, 85% of the students gave exams.
- Of these, 72% of the students scored between 80% and 100% marks and only 3% scored less than 40% marks.
- Teachers, supervisors and core team members participated in vigorous training and capacity building workshops throughout the year to enable communities towards being engaged in the education of their children.
- Overall, this program fostered enhanced learning among students, indicating that the support has led to a better understanding among parents for the need to pursue continued quality education.

We are delighted to report the renewal of our partnership with Blue Dart Express Limited for 38 classes in Farrukhabad and Lucknow, which covered the quality education of 950 children in 2018-19.

In 2018-19, Info Edge India Ltd supported 20 classes in Farrukhabad and Lucknow, covering quality education of 500 children for the year 2018-19.

Our new partners, Daffodil Software Pvt Ltd supported 5 classes covering 125 students in Farrukhabad & Lucknow.

In 2018-2019, E&H Foundation campaigned for the cause of Quality Education on our crowdfunding partners' website. Our ongoing project on LetzChange brought together 150 like-minded and committed individuals who helped us mobilize ~ Rs 12 Lakh which covered the education of around 300 children.

This year, E&H Foundation took a new initiative with its efforts of reaching out to donors outside India. E & H Foundation is now a permanent member of the Global Giving Family, which is the largest online community connecting nonprofits, donors and companies around the world. We started our campaign on Global Giving in September 2018 and have steadfastly moved on from a project leader to a superstar partner, all because of our supporters.

We are now one of the top ranked organizations on Global Giving, thanks to the unwavering support from our donors and socially conscious individuals all over the globe. So far, our project has raised \$8581 and has made 64 new friends, all united for a good cause. Their collective effort of supporting the education of children has enabled new horizons for E&H Foundation. In 2019-2020, we will further work on strengthening this initiative and will be reaching out to more supporters to solidify our partnership. E&H will continue to expand this collaboration with its foreign donors to impact more children and link them to conscious beings globally.

AIRTEL DELHI HALF MARATHON





ENABLING FIRST-GEN LEARNERS TO READ & WRITE



Priyank*, 8 years old, recently graduated from Std3 Gyanshala in Farrukhabad. His favorite subject is English. Priyank has a younger sister, Kirti* (6 years old), who also studies in E&H foundation funded Std 2. Priyank and Kirti have two younger brothers; Dev who is 3 years old and youngest, who is 4 months old. The family is yet to name their youngest born. Kirti has never been to any other school before she joined E&H Foundation's Gyanshala classes and is quite fascinated with her new life. She likes going to class and is especially fond of her teacher. She looks up to her brother for any support, often seeking his advice and feedback on her Maths problems, as he is exceptionally good at it and is two grades ahead of her. Ever since Kirti started attending classes since 2018, her parents feel she has become more active and talkative at home, often reciting poems at home. Kirti's teacher feels it's too early to comment on her progress, since she has been enrolled only last year, but she believes Kirti to be a quiet, energetic and observant student, often eager to understand, learn and ask questions. It became a proud moment for the entire family when Kirti and Priyank become the first in their family to ever read and write. Often, Priyank can be spotted in his house, reading out the daily news from the local Hindi newspaper, for the benefit of the entire family.

In the absence of E&H Foundation and Gyanshala classes, Kirti and Priyank would have probably not been able to access quality education within their locality and would not be able to read and write.

THE ROAD AHEAD

- In the academic year 2019-2020, E&H Foundation aims to support the education of 7500 underprivileged children in the most dismal sections of India.
- Donors are being identified to provide education to students from Std 1-5 and also for higher classes.
- In long term E&H Foundation aims to extend coverage of our activities till class 10th and we are exploring other successful and proven models to partner with.
- By 2025, E&H Foundation aims to provide quality education to 1 Lakh underprivileged children in India
