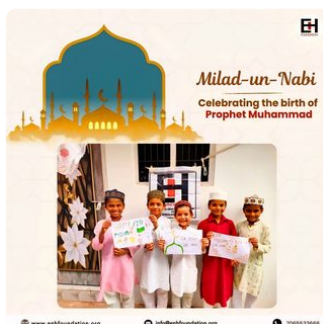

### Milad-un-Nabi (5 September 2025)

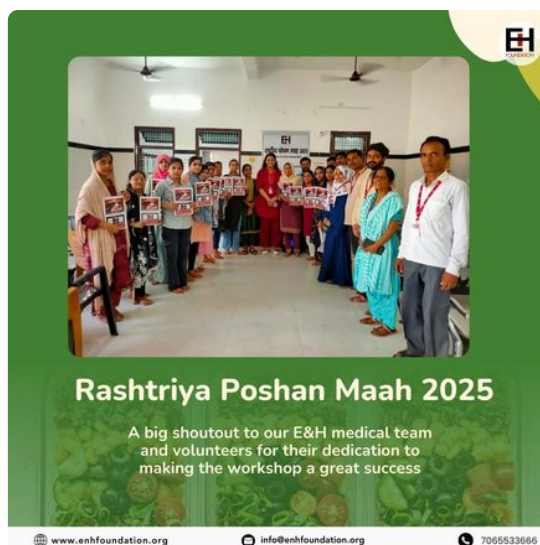

### Teacher's Day (7 September 2025)

Teacher's Day was celebrated in recognition of the invaluable role educators play in shaping young minds and strengthening communities. The dedication, passion, and guidance of teachers continue to inspire children to learn, grow, and dream. The occasion acknowledged their contribution in nurturing confidence and resilience among students.



### Rashtriya Poshan Maah — Nutrition Awareness Workshop (27 August 2025)



E&H Foundation marked the 7th Rashtriya Poshan Maah by organizing a nutrition awareness workshop at its Health Centre in Shamshabad. The session, led by Ms. Amita Pandey and Mr. Anurag Mishra under the guidance of the CEO, focused on promoting healthy dietary practices and addressing malnutrition. The workshop was attended by 54 women, including those in the reproductive age group, adolescent girls, and children.

It included demonstrations of nutritious food items and a live preparation of a sattu drink, highlighting its health benefits. Hemoglobin tests were conducted on-site to identify anemia, and participants including ASHA workers and pregnant women shared their experiences.

## IMPACT STORY

### Shafaq: A Journey of Health & Hope

A volunteer from the E&H Foundation shared her journey toward improved health, highlighting the impact of timely medical intervention. Experiencing fatigue and weakness, she discovered through a health check-up that her hemoglobin level was critically low. With proper guidance from doctors, including dietary changes and prescribed treatment, she was able to recover and better understand how to care for her health. Her story reflects the importance of accessible healthcare and the positive outcomes of informed medical support.



### **Santosh Kumari: Access Before Urgency**

In many rural communities, healthcare often begins only when a problem becomes difficult to ignore. Regular check-ups are not always accessible, leaving many without clarity about their health.

Santosh Kumari, from Kisroli village in Nawabganj, Farrukhabad, attended a healthcare camp in her community. At the camp, she underwent basic investigations, including checks for blood sugar, blood pressure, and dental health. Following the screening, the doctor advised her to visit a government hospital for further consultation.

For Santosh Kumari, the camp became an important first step — providing her with initial health assessment and clear direction on what to do next. It highlights how bringing healthcare closer to communities can enable timely action and informed decision-making.

## CEO'S VISIT TO PROJECT SITES — FARRUKHABAD

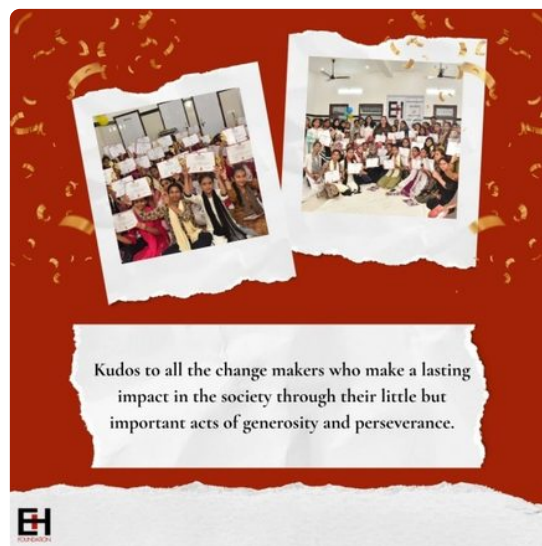
### Visit to Satya Bharti School, Jyona (18 July 2025)
