Gandhi Jayanti (2 October 2024)

Across Delhi and Farrukhabad, over 500 volunteers came together to honor Mahatma Gandhi's ideals of peace and service. The celebrations included organized sanitation drives, peace processions fostering unity and communal harmony, and youth-led eco-art installations created entirely from recycled materials.



Dussehra (12 October 2024)

Learning centers came alive with engaging activities that blended culture with education. Drama performances depicted the victory of good over evil, while storytelling sessions helped children emotionally connect with cultural values. Art competitions encouraged creative expression on themes of truth, courage, and justice.



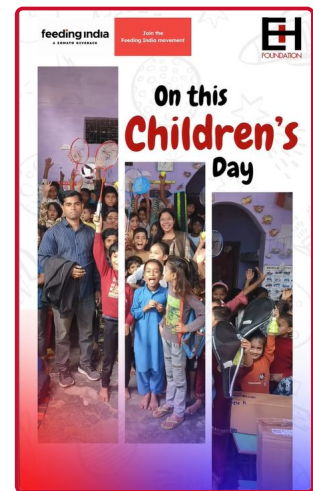
Diwali (1 November 2024)

Special sessions emphasized education as a form of light, helping children understand the symbolic connection between learning and illumination.

Children's Day (14 November 2024)

To celebrate every child's potential, dedicated activities were organized across learning centers. Children participated in educational games, creative art workshops, and talent showcases that highlighted their diverse abilities. Fun-filled learning sessions, including storytelling and environmental awareness activities, helped nurture curiosity and confidence among young learners.



Guru Nanak Jayanti (November 2024)

The celebrations honored the teachings of Guru Nanak Dev Ji on equality, compassion, and selfless service. Interactive sessions helped children understand the relevance of these values in modern life. A langar (community meal) brought learners together, symbolizing equality and unity regardless of background or circumstance.

Christmas Celebrations & Winter Camp (25 December 2024)

The festive season was marked by engaging Winter Camp activities that combined fun and learning. Children enjoyed art and craft workshops where they created Christmas-themed decorations and greeting cards. Storytelling and quiz competitions added an educational dimension, while games and team activities promoted teamwork and social bonding among students.

DoDM Conference Participation — 21 November 2024

E&H Foundation demonstrated its commitment to resilience and community wellbeing through its participation in the conference. The team presented innovative disaster preparedness models, engaged with policymakers and key stakeholders, and highlighted scalable education and healthcare interventions.

Partnering with Zomato — Feeding India

The collaboration with Feeding India by Zomato marks a significant step toward addressing food insecurity. In Phase 1, 2,000 nutritious meals were distributed to vulnerable communities. Looking ahead, the initiative aims to distribute 10,000 meals over the course of 2025.

Comprehensive Preventive Healthcare Program

At E&H Foundation, we are translating our belief in accessible healthcare into action through our Comprehensive Preventive Healthcare Program in Farrukhabad, Uttar Pradesh. The program reached more than 450 individuals, providing essential services such as general health check-ups, eye and dental care, health awareness, and preventive care counselling. The initiative also supported beneficiaries in accessing government health schemes including Ayushman Bharat and PM-JAY.

The program places a strong emphasis on gender-inclusive healthcare, ensuring access for children, adolescent girls, women, men, and the elderly.

Comprehensive Education Program

Around 1,549 students benefited from peer group learning initiatives that encouraged collaboration, improved academic engagement, and supported overall learning outcomes.

Health Center Inauguration — Farrukhabad (14 December 2024)

This marked a major milestone for the organization. A fully functional Healthcare Hub was inaugurated to provide free first-level medical services to the community. The event was attended by local leaders and community members, and a collective health pledge was taken to reaffirm the importance of preventive care.



**Ms. Kanchan — Nursing Assistant**

Ms. Kanchan joined the team as a Nursing Assistant on 13th December 2024. Her addition marks an important step in strengthening the Foundation's healthcare services at the grassroots level. Her presence is expected to enhance the efficiency of health interventions, support medical operations at the Healthcare Hub, and contribute to improved outreach and care for beneficiaries.

SUCCESS STORIES

**Education: Tabassum**

Tabassum, a bright learner, has shown exceptional academic and personal growth at Gyan Shala since 2022–23. She has strengthened her skills in Mathematics and Science while significantly improving her reading and writing abilities. She actively participates in class discussions, demonstrates leadership in group activities, and has emerged as a confident peer helper.

Health Program: Munni Begum

Munni Begum, a resident of Sikandarpur village in Farrukhabad, had been struggling with poor vision for years, with no accessible healthcare facilities nearby.

In May 2025, a mobilizer from the E&H Foundation informed her about a health camp in the village. She attended and received a comprehensive check-up, learning for the first time that she had cataract and refractive error and was advised to undergo surgery.

"I found out at the camp that I have cataract. Now I know I need an operation, and I am ready to get it done."

Her story has inspired others in the village to seek timely medical care and recognize the importance of regular health check-ups.
