Healthcare: 124 health camps conducted reaching more than 12,546 individuals. Services included general health check-ups, anemia and malnutrition screening, eye and dental care, and preventive health counselling, with support to access government health schemes.

Education: 132 students enrolled in the Vidhyadhan Scholarship Program; 942 students benefited from peer group learning; 2,530 students through Gyanshala; 1,164 through peer learning overall.

Maha Navami (1 October 2025)

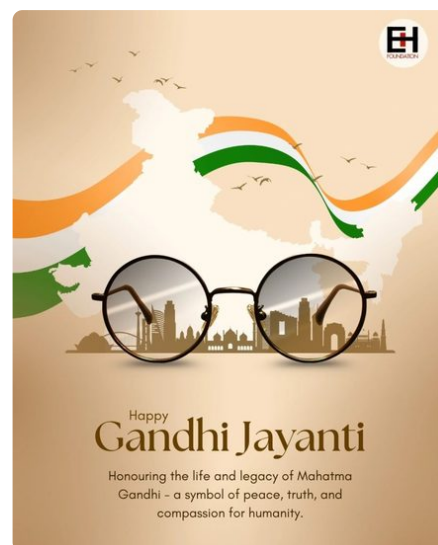

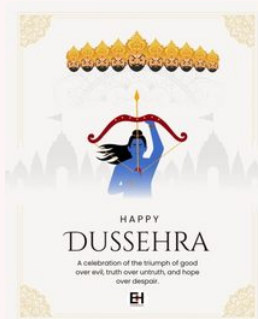
Gandhi Jayanti (2 October 2025)

This occasion serves as a reminder that small acts of service and care can lead to meaningful change.

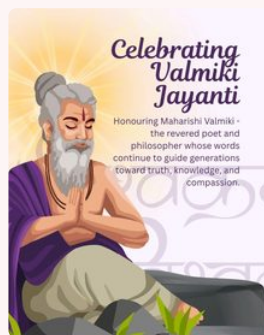


Dussehra (2 October 2025)



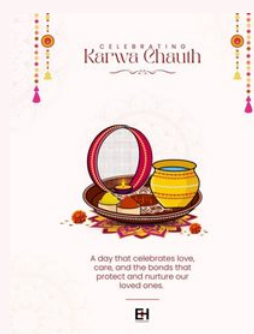

Karwa Chauth (10 October 2025)

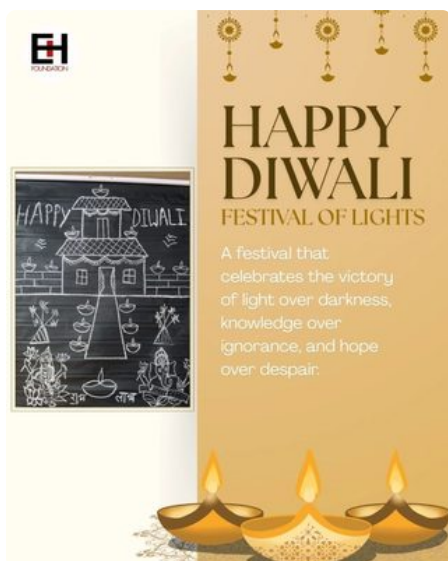

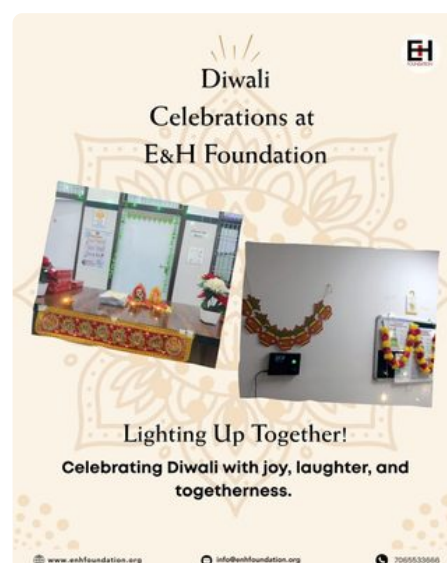


Diwali (20 October 2025)

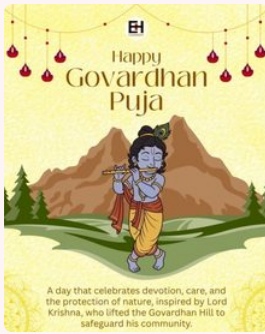

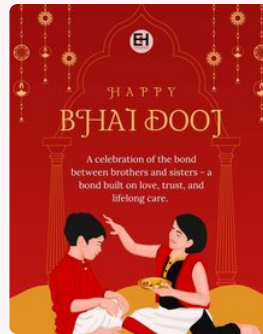


Govardhan Puja (22 October 2025)



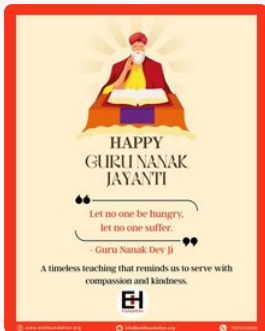

Children's Day (14 November 2025)



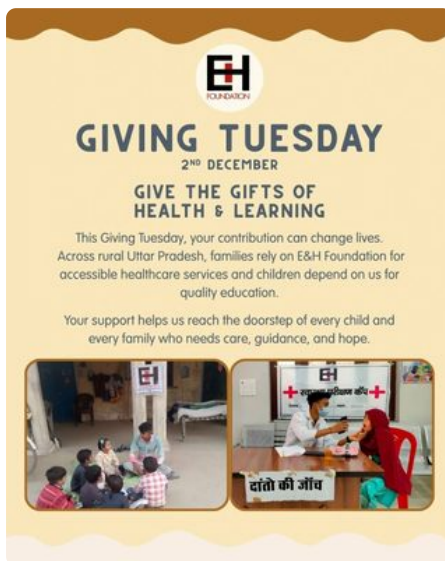

LAUNCH: COMPREHENSIVE PREVENTIVE HEALTHCARE PROGRAM



E&H Foundation is pleased to share the successful launch of its Comprehensive Preventive Healthcare Program on 18 December 2025 in Azad Nagar, Shamshabad block, Farrukhabad district, Uttar Pradesh, in partnership with IndiaFirst Life Insurance Company Limited.

The launch marked an important step towards strengthening grassroots healthcare accessibility. The program was inaugurated by Dr. Sarwar Iqbal (Medical Officer In-Charge), along with Mr. Afaq Hussain Gazi (Assistant Development Officer, Panchayat) and Mr. Nitin Kumar (Ward Member).

A preventive healthcare camp was organised offering free services including medical consultations, blood pressure and blood sugar tests, comprehensive eye examinations, dental care, and personalised health and nutrition guidance. The initiative witnessed strong community participation, with 94 beneficiaries served on the very first day.

This program is designed as a sustained initiative aimed at reaching over 4,000 community members across the Shamshabad and Nawabganj blocks.

IMPACT STORIES

Rajesh Kumar — Eye, Dental & Sugar Check-Up

From eye testing to dental and sugar check-ups, Rajesh Kumar received comprehensive healthcare support at a free camp in Siroli village. Access to these essential services enabled early identification of health concerns and provided him with the guidance needed to take better care of his well-being. E&H Foundation continues to work towards ensuring that preventive healthcare remains accessible, affordable, and available to all.



Bitto Begum — Anaemia Awareness

Bitto Begum, a resident of Pinebagh village, received a full health check-up at one of our outreach camps, including eye, dental, blood, and sugar tests. When her haemoglobin level was found to be as low as 8, she was guided by doctors on simple yet effective dietary changes, such as incorporating more green vegetables into her meals. With this awareness, she now feels more confident in managing her health.

Muhammad Zain — Education Success

From struggling with basic multiplication tables to confidently learning Maths, Hindi, and English, Muhammad Zain’s journey highlights the transformative power of the right academic support. Through E&H Foundation’s Peer Learning Classes, he has steadily built strong foundational skills, demonstrating how consistent guidance can unlock a child’s potential.



Hafida — Reading & Writing

Hafida’s journey is a powerful example of perseverance and the impact of patient teaching. Once struggling with Hindi, she can now confidently read her textbooks and write independently. With regular support and encouragement at E&H Foundation’s learning centres, she gradually strengthened her language skills and built self-confidence. Today, she approaches learning with pride and motivation.
